Together with the UC Irvine Department of Philosophy, the faculty who make up the LPS department contribute to the undergraduate curriculum at UC Irvine by teaching courses for a number of philosophy-related degree programs.

LPS faculty annually instruct and mentor 25 graduate students who go on to teaching and research careers at top educational institutions around the world.
